Sarmcol plays in Woodstock

THE Sarmcol Workers' Co-operative cultural group, currently on a five-week tour of the Western and Southern Cape, will stop in at the Community Arts Project in Woodstock for three performances this weekend.

The Natal group will perform "The Long March" and their new play, "Bhambatha's Children", at the Chapel Street venue on Thursday, Friday and Sunday at 8 pm.

Entrance is R3 and tickets are obtainable at the door.

The Co-operative was formed after 970 workers were

dismissed after a legal strike.

"Bhambatha's Children" recreates workers' history from the Bhambatha uprising in 1906 to today.

"Long March" deals with the workers' struggle for recognition, the strike, their dismissal, the slaying of two union leaders and their battle for re-instatement.

"We hope you will come and see our plays and support our struggle. You will not be disappointed in our performance", a spokesperson for the group has promised.
