Mozambicano in September 2003. Her work won first prize in the *Envente Bolsa de Turismo* competition, as a result of which she was offered her first solo exhibition, *Metamorfose de saco* at AMF, which in turn led to an invitation to participate in a collective exhibition, *ARTE no Feminino* (Women in Art) at the Museu Nacional de Arte in Maputo. This further exposure of her works resulted in an invitation to the *Faira de Arte Contemporania* in Portugal, and to Nairobi as a representative of Mozambique for the British Council's pan-African *InterAction Networking Forum*.

In March 2006 Lizette was invited to participate in the Cape Town Festival, and since April has participated in the residency programme at the Castle of Good Hope where she shares a studio with other artists from South Africa. She recently completed a residency at Greatmore Studios which culminated in another solo exhibition. The Joao Ferreira Gallery in Cape Town currently has her works on display. Her work speaks to everyone and carries the rich textures of Africa. Also using skins and hessian, Lizette designs and sews clothes which are both wearable fashion and art pieces.
